Dear Mr. Gribetz,

In response to your question, we enclose the following:

1. The cost per United Soup Kitchens meal, including delivery, to the recipient's home is \$2.25
2. The cost per meal for each person eating in the United Soup Kitchens (no delivery) is \$1.80

Total meals to be provided in year 2004: 730,000

Of the 2,000 delivered each day of the year, 750 are to Holocaust survivors. The average annual cost per recipient is \$820 for year 2004.

Total NIS 5,170,000 = USD 1,175,000

Total 3,800 families (15,600 individuals)

Of these 3,400 individuals are Holocaust survivors


