Upon review and consideration of the January 14, 2014 letter of the Executive Director of the Victim List Project recommending with the approval of the Special Master and the Deputy Special Master the transfer of the paper (analog) CRT-II bank records currently in Zurich to the Swiss Federal Archives in Bern and the preparation of the paper (analog) CRT-II bank records by the Swiss Federal Archives for longtime archiving, it is hereby

ORDERED that the recommendation of the Executive Director of the Victim List Project, described in the letter annexed hereto, is approved and that \$28,000.00 be allocated to pay for the transfer of the paper (analog) CRT-II bank records to the Swiss Federal Archives in Bern and the preparation of the paper (analog) CRT-II bank records by the Swiss Federal Archives for longtime archiving. The Signatories to

the Settlement Fund are hereby directed to transfer immediately \$28,000.00 from the Settlement Fund to the Conference on Material Claims Against Germany, which serves as the Court's agent for purposes of administration of the Victim List Project. Upon receipt, the Claims Conference shall transfer the sum to the Swiss Federal Archives upon the presentation of an invoice from the Swiss Federal Archives for the transfer and preparation of the paper (analog) CRT-II bank records.
