KORMAN, J.:

The Claims Resolution Tribunal (“CRT”), which under the Court’s authority has been processing claims for Swiss bank accounts principally by heirs of those who perished in the Holocaust, has now concluded its work. The CRT, located in Zurich, Switzerland, operated as an association under Swiss law. Consequently, the affairs of the CRT cannot be concluded without a formal process of liquidation of the association under Swiss law. I appoint Andreas Casutt and Thomas Graft, who are members of a Swiss law firm that has represented the CRT over the ten years of its existence, to be the liquidators of the association and I have directed them to commence liquidation of the CRT in accordance with the procedures required by Swiss law.
