- (1) The order of this Court, dated and entered on November 22, 2000, adopting in its entirety the Special Master's Proposed Plan of Allocation and Distribution of Settlement Proceeds, and
- (2) The order of this Court, dated and entered on December 8, 2000, appointing two Special Masters under Rule 53 of the FRCP to establish, organize, and supervise the claims resolution process, using the claims resolution tribunal provided for in the Plan of Allocation and Distribution as approved by the Court, and

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- (3) The memorandum and order of this Court, dated and entered on December 8, 2000, directing that the implementation of the distribution plan is to proceed immediately in accordance with specified procedures and timetables and providing that as necessary the Court may issue additional orders to implement the distribution plan.
